Trombone Care and Cleaning

(single-page version)

I. Slide Cleaning

- 1. Set up cheese cloth cleaning rod.
- 2. Flush water through slide.
- 3. Run a Brass-Saver through the slide & leadpipe (separately if possible).
- 4. Cleaning rod the outer slide with alcohol, water, or in an extreme case, brass polish (see other PDF).
- 5. Cleaning rod inner-slide (or skip it). Avoid contact with the leadpipe (see other PDF).
- 6. Rinse slide tubes.
- 7. Wipe inner slide with alcohol or water. Rinse (wipe again with water if you used alcohol.

II. Slide Lubricating

CREAM:

- 1. Apply a small amount to slide stockings.
- 2. Spread cream to outer slide tubes.
- 3. Spray water.
- 4. If the slide is slow, thin the coating with rag & water. SLIDE LUBE
- 1. Usually apply a small squirt or two to the inner slide past 7th position.

III. Bell Care

- 1. Shine with water on soft cloth for cosmetics. Gently wipe dry.
- 2. Rinse tuning slides.
- 3. Alcohol (occasionally) tuning slide tubes then rinse.
- 4. Add tuning slide grease.

IV. Valve Care -

- 1. Apply heavy oil (Hetman 13) to the external linkage parts & under the rotor valve cap if rotor.
- 2. Remove the main tuning slide to drip light oil (Hetman 11) down that tube while moving the valve.
- 3. Drain for a few minutes without the slide

V. **Mouthpiece Cleaning**

- 1. Run water & brush through shank from the bottom.
- 2. Dish/hand soap on the rest.
- 3. Silver cream if desired.
